About 131.5 kilometre long pipeline has been constructed for importing diesel from India. Out of this, 126.5 kilometre pipeline is in Bangladesh and 5 kilometre line is in India. The international pipeline will carry diesel from the **Siliguri** based marketing terminal of the Numaligarh Refinery Limited to **Parbatipur depot of Bangladesh Petroleum Corporation (BPC).**
